Matthew 4:20	1	1	Immediately they left their nets and followed Him.
Matthew 4:22	1	1	Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him.
Matthew 4:25	1	1	Large crowds followed Him from Galilee and the Decapolis and Jerusalem and Judea and from beyond the Jordan.
Matthew 8:1	1	1	When Jesus came down from the mountain, large crowds followed Him.
Matthew 8:10	1	1	Now when Jesus heard this, He marveled and said to those who were following , "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel.
Matthew 8:19	1	1	Then a scribe came and said to Him, "Teacher, I will follow You wherever You go."
Matthew 8:22	1	1	But Jesus said [^] to him, " Follow Me, and allow the dead to bury their own dead."
Matthew 8:23	1	1	When He got into the boat, His disciples followed Him.
Matthew 9:9	2	2	As Jesus went on from there, He saw a man called Matthew, sitting in the tax collector's booth; and He said [^] to him, " Follow Me! " And he got up and followed Him.

Matthew 19:28	1	1	And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
Matthew 20:29	1	1	As they were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed Him.
Matthew 20:34	1	1	Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him.
Matthew 21:9	1	1	The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed , were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"
Matthew 26:58	1	1	But Peter was following Him at a distance as far as the courtyard of the high priest, and entered in, and sat down with the officers to see the outcome.
Matthew 27:55	1	1	Many women were there looking on from a distance, who had followed Jesus from Galilee while ministering to Him.
Mark 1:18	1	1	Immediately they left their nets and followed Him.
