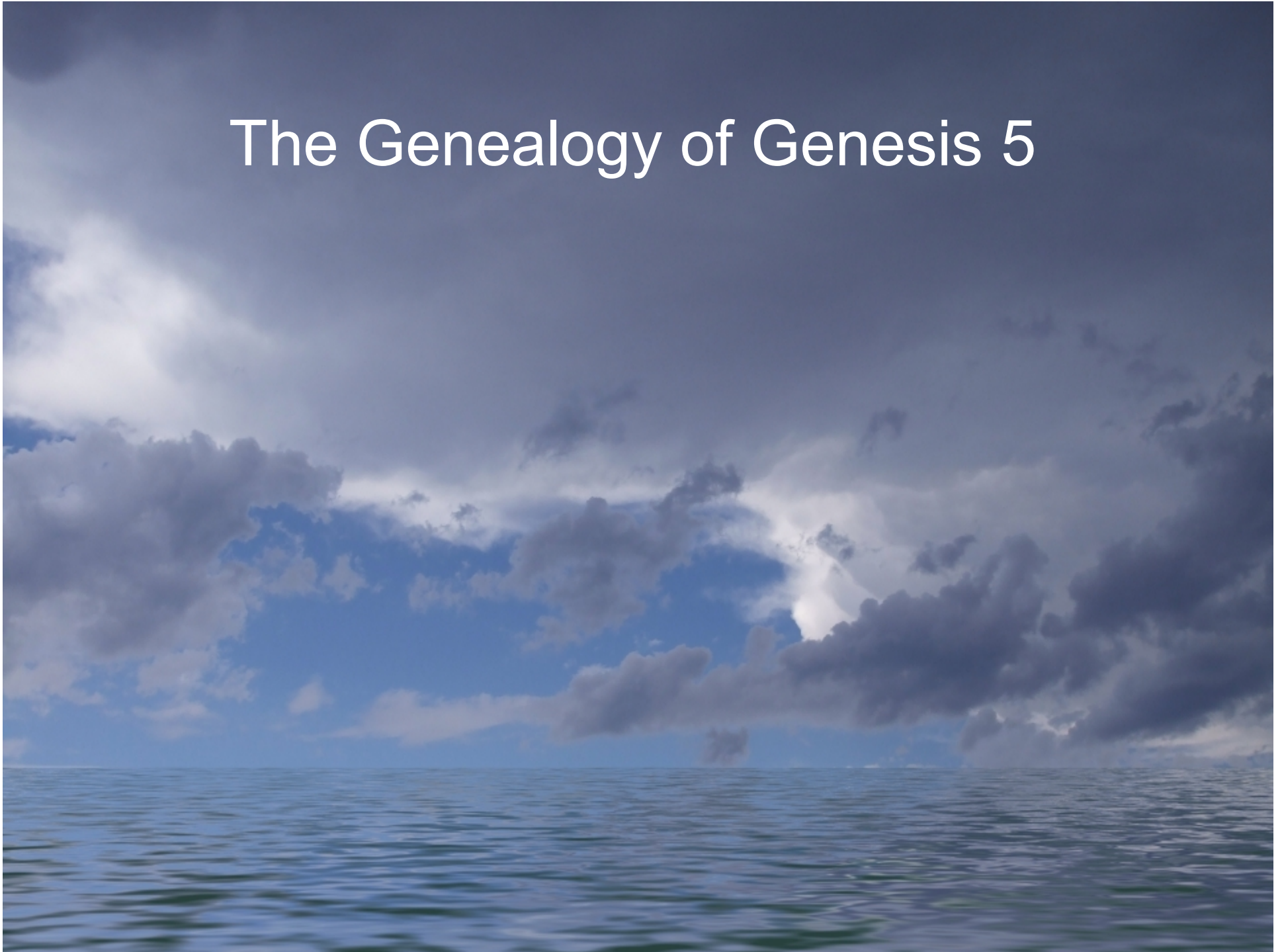
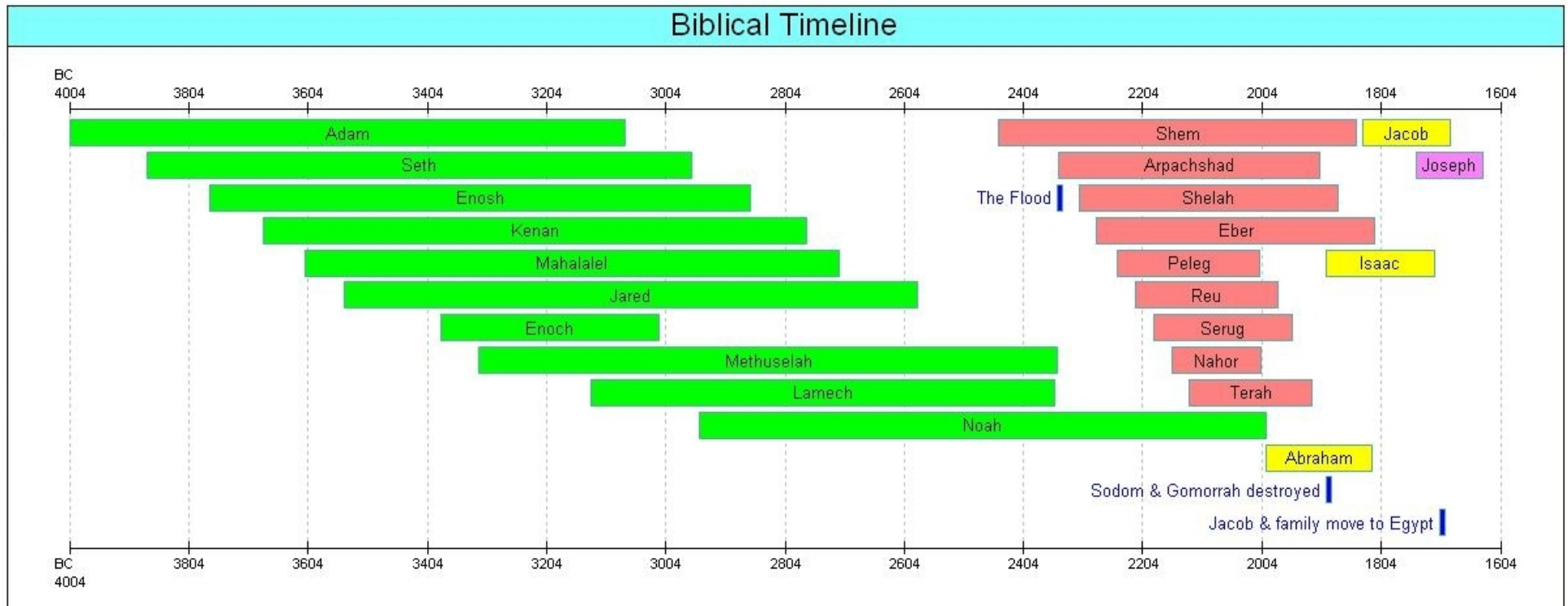


The Genealogy of Genesis 5

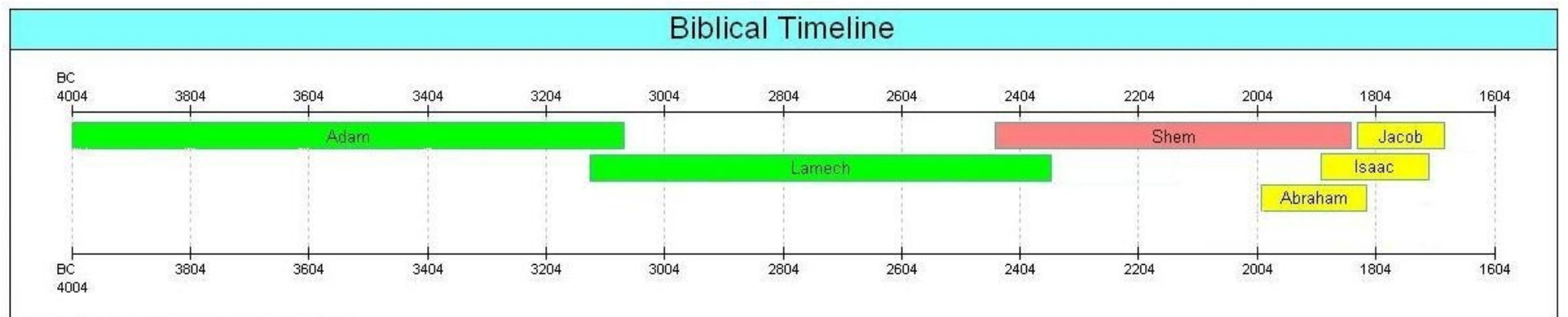


Timeline of Adam to Joseph

Adam

This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day when God created man, **He made him in the likeness of God.** He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them Man in the day when they were created. When Adam had lived one hundred and thirty years, **he became the father of a son in his own likeness, according to his image,** and named him Seth. Genesis 5:1-3 (New American Standard Bible)

So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Kenan were nine hundred and ten years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years, **and he died.**

Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years, **and he died.**

So all the days of Noah were nine hundred and fifty years, **and he died.**

Enoch

Enoch lived sixty-five years, and became the father of Methuselah. Then Enoch walked with God three hundred years after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had other sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.** Gen. 5:21-24 (NASB)

Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men: *“See, the Lord is coming with thousands upon thousands of his holy ones to judge everyone, and to convict all the ungodly of all the ungodly acts they have done in the ungodly way, and of all the harsh words ungodly sinners have spoken against him.”* Jude 1:14-15 (NIV)

We note here that the middle letter for death is switched so that it forms another word "and."

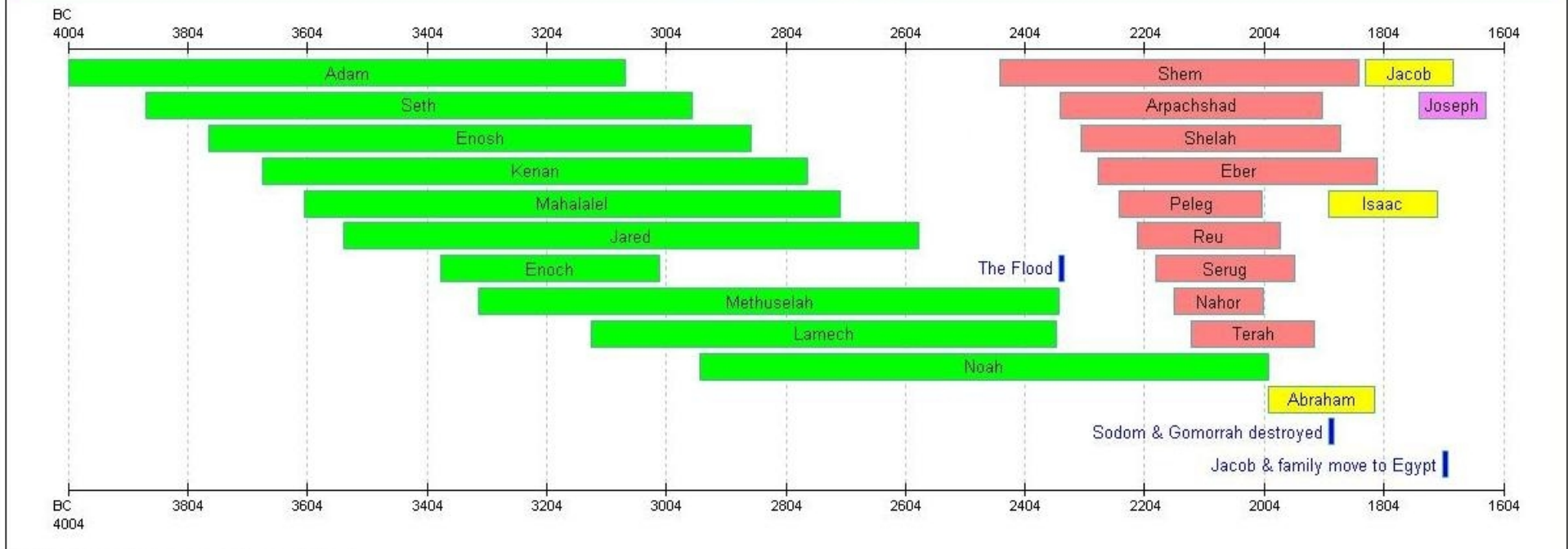

Lamech

Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and became the father of a son. Now he called his name Noah, saying, **“This one will give us rest from our work and from the toil of our hands arising from the ground which the LORD has cursed.”** Genesis 5:28-29 (NASB)

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; **Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field; By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you return to the ground, Because from it you were taken; For you are dust, And to dust you shall return."** Genesis 3:17-19 (NASB)

So the LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, "Cursed are you above all the livestock and all the wild animals! You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; **he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.**" Gen. 3:14-15 (NIV)
